Preparation Method: HEK 293T cell expression system

Particle Size: ED₅₀ = 3-

Storage Buffer: Lyophilized from 0.05M phosphate
buffer, 0.075M NaCl, pH 7.4.

Storage Instruction: Store at -20°C. Aliquot the product
after reconstitution to avoid repeated freezing/thawing
cycles. Reconstituted protein can be stored at 4°C for a
limited period of time; it does not show any change after
two weeks at 4°C.
