PRODUCTION PROCEDURES	Antibody was affinity purified using an epitope specific to FIP200/RB1CC1 immobilized on solid support.

The epitope recognized by A301-574A maps to a region between residue 250 and 300 human 200 kDa FAK family kinase-interacting protein (RB1-inducible coiled-coil 1) using the numbering given in entry NP_055596.2 (GeneID 9821).

Immunoglobulin concentration was determined using Beer's Law where 1mg/mL IgG has an A280 of 1.4.

APPLICATIONS	Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.
