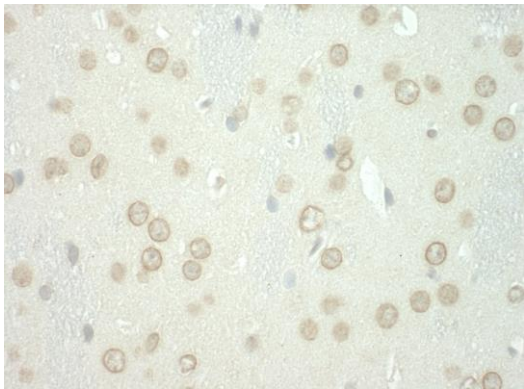
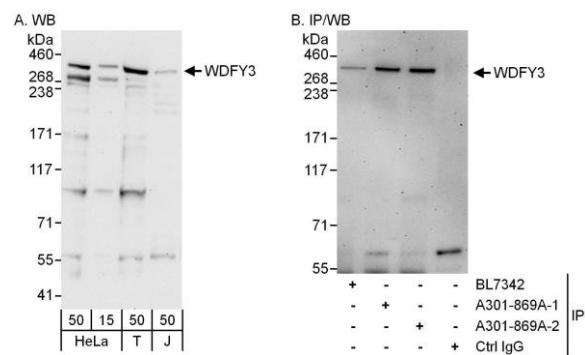

**Detection of human WDFY3 by western blot and immunoprecipitation.** *Samples:* Whole cell lysate from HeLa (15 and 50 µg for WB; 1 mg for IP, 20% of IP loaded), HEK293T (T; 50 µg) and Jurkat (J; 50 µg) cells. *Antibodies:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-WDFY3 antibody A301-869A (lot A301-869A-2) used for WB at 0.4 µg/ml (A) and 1 µg/ml (B) and used for IP at 6 µg/mg lysate. WDFY3 was also immunoprecipitated by a previous lot (lot A301-869A-1) of this antibody and by rabbit anti-WDFY3 antibody BL7342, which recognizes a downstream epitope. *Detection:* Chemiluminescence with exposure times of 3 minutes (A) and 30 seconds (B).

**Detection of human WDFY3 by immunohistochemistry.** *Sample:* FFPE section of human glioblastoma. *Antibody:* Affinity purified rabbit anti-WDFY3 (Cat. No. A301-869A Lot2) used at a dilution of 1:5,000 (0.2µg/ml). *Detection:* DAB
