Recombinant antibody was purified from cell culture supernatant.

PROCEDURES

Immunogen was a peptide representing a region between residue 75 and 125 (Hinge) of

hlgG4 using the numbering given in entry P01861 (Gene ID 3503).

APPLICATIONS Centrifuge tube to remove product from lid. Optimal working dilutions should be determined

experimentally by the investigator. Prepare working dilution immediately before use.

A700–113CF is the carrier–free version of RMAB1457–1B11, which is qualified for use in Western Blot, Immunoprecipitation, Immunohistochemistry, and/or Immunocytochemistry. The format of A700–113CF is designed for compatibility with the labeling of the antibody such as with fluorochromes, metal isotopes, oligonucleotides, and enzymes. Upon

completion of labeling, the user must empirically define the assay dependent concentration

for use.
