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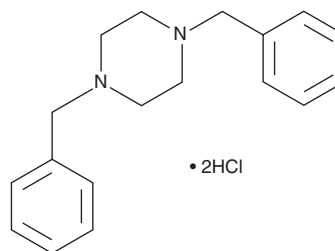

Description

Benzylpiperazines (BZP) are stimulant drugs which inhibit monoamine uptake.^{1,2} BZP and substituted derivatives, such as 1-(3,4-methylenedioxybenzyl)piperazine, have been identified as designer drugs or drugs of abuse.^{3,4} 1,4-Dibenzylpiperazine (hydrochloride) is a common impurity produced as a reaction byproduct during the synthesis of BZP. The biological and toxicological properties of this compound are not known. This product is intended for research and forensic applications.
