Laboratory Procedures

N^E-(1-Carboxymethyl)-L-lysine-d₂ (CML-d₂) is intended for use as an internal standard for the quantification of CML (Item No. 16483) by GC- or LC-MS. The accuracy of the sample weight in this vial is between 5% over and 2% under the amount shown on the vial. If better precision is required, the deuterated standard should be quantitated against a more precisely weighed unlabeled standard by constructing a standard curve of peak intensity ratios (deuterated versus unlabeled).

Description

CML is an advanced glycation end product (AGE), produced by the oxidative modification of glycated proteins during oxidative stress. 1-3 Levels of CML increase with aging and during diabetes, cancer, vascular disease, and other pathologies marked by oxidative stress. 1,4,5 CML activates the membrane-bound receptor for AGEs (RAGE), triggering signaling through MAPKs and NF-kB, whereas truncation of RAGE produces a soluble protein that binds CML and reduces signaling.^{6,7}
