IgG molecules are synthesized and secreted by plasma B cells. Secondary Antibodies are available in a variety of formats and conjugate types. When choosing a secondary antibody product, consideration must be given to species and immunoglobulin specificity, conjugate type, fragment and chain specificity, level of cross-reactivity, and host-species source and fragment composition. using Rat IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any
unwanted reactivities, papain digestion and chromatographic separation. Assay by
immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Biotin and anti-Rabbit
Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Papain or anti-Rabbit IgG F(c).

Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
Expiration:	Expiration date is one (1) year from date of receipt.
